In this Theology of the Body (TOB) lesson, your child will learn that all of **Creation is a Gift** given to us by God including all it contains (resources, beauty, companionship, etc.) and He places it within our care to provide for our needs and to enjoy. We show respect and reverence to how God designed nature by treating creation with care, and therefore responsibly working with, protecting, cultivating, and conserving the earth's natural provisions.

In this lesson, your child will hear the story *The Animal Hedge* by Paul Fleischman and discuss the important elements of creation in the story. Then they will identity ways God provides for us through creation and will express appreciation and wonder for His resources.
