KINDERGARTEN: TOB LESSON 5



THEME: DIGNITY OF WORK

SOW THE SEED



Dear Parents.

In this Theology of the Body (TOB) lesson, we will discuss the theme, **Dignity of Work**. When God created man, He set him within the Garden of Eden "to till and keep it." That means work was God's loving plan for us even before original sin made work more burdensome. We are capable of thinking about and planning what we do (i.e. intellect and free will), therefore God entrusts man with the care of creation. God reveals the dignity of work through his act of creation. Therefore, man reflects the image of God through his daily tasks, work, chores, duties, and responsibilities.

In this lesson, we will revisit the story *Blueberries for Sal* and demonstrate that man has similarities and differences from other created beings through asking guided learning questions about the work done by Sal and her mom, as well as, by little bear and mama bear. These types of questions help the children to use their reason to uncover deep truths about the human person. Next, the students are asked to reflect on a time that they worked hard, and what they did to rest afterwards. Then, they will discuss the work that God did in creating the world and how He rested afterwards.

For the activity, the students will be invited to make a thank you card for someone who works hard to make the school a better place. Then, they will hand-deliver their notes, if possible.
